

10 STEPS FOR DIAPERING

- 1. Organize the supplies**
 - a. Diaper
 - b. Wipes
 - c. Ointment – when needed
 - d. Paper – shoulder to heel (optional)
 - e. Gloves (optional)
- 2. Bring child to table, remove diaper, and clean bottom**
 - a. Supervision
 - b. Interactions
- 3. Dispose of diaper, wipes, and gloves**
 - a. Hands free trashcan
 - b. Supervision
- 4. Use of wipes to remove gross soil**
 - a. Adult's hands
 - b. Child's hands
- 5. Put on clean diaper**
- 6. Wash child's hands with soap and running water**
- 7. Return child to play**
 - a. Limit recontamination
- 8. Clean table**
 - a. Soap and water mixture
- 9. Sanitize table**
 - a. Appropriate time lapse or air dry for bleach and water
 - b. Per manufacturer's instructions
- 10. Wash adult's hands with soap and running water**
